- It is an offence to provide false or misleading information about goods you may be carrying, with "on the spot" fines of up to \$420 or prosecution. In addition you may be prosecuted for undeclared goods imported in contravention of the *Biosecurity Act 2015*.
- Upon departure from Australia you must also declare to an Officer of Customs if you are carrying AUD\$10,000 or more in Australian or foreign currency equivalent.
